Monthly Outdoor Health and Safety Inspection

Playground Safety Checklist Inspection by the Health and Safety Committee

- Supports: equipment is secure in the ground. No footings are exposed.
- Bolts, Nuts, Screws, Nails, Other Hardware: no pieces are missing, loose, or exposed. Pinch or crush points are covered.
- Rust: no rust is visible.
- Wood: no splinters, cracks or sharp edges.
- Ropes: there are no entanglement or strangulation hazards.
- Holes and Gaps: All gaps between parts are either too small for a child's head to enter (generally 3 inches) or large enough for the child's body to pass through (over 10 inches) to prevent strangulation. There are no gaps to trap limbs.
- Equipment: is age appropriate and safe for use. Intended user labels are visible on equipment.
- Surface: the surface under and around equipment is appropriate and able to cushion any falls.
- Location: structures are 6 feet away from any other barrier (fence, sandbox)
- Litter: the playground is free of litter, glass, sharp objects, animal feces, and all other hazards.
- Boundaries: fences and gates are in good repair.
